



Lancashire County Council Cabinet formally approve Community Asset Transfer..

As you are all aware Hornby Pool had been leased to Lancaster City Council and they made a decision to stop operating the pool from 31 March 2017..

The pool was closed and Lune Valley Community Society was formed to negotiate with Lancashire County Council an agreement to run the pool for the benefit of the community.

After a great deal of hard work, discussion and submissions Lancashire County Council last week agreed to transfer the pool to Lune Valley Community Society Ltd .

A one-off sum of £27,000 will be paid to LVCS in order to support the transition and help contribute to necessary technical, legal and set-up costs.

This means that LVCS can now officially move forward to re-open the pool when all administration procedures are completed.

And it looks like that we should still be able to open to the public immediately after Easter and we will advise an actual date ASAP.

At the moment we hope that this work will take place from the 24th of March – Details to follow
