




## Countryside Society



On **Friday 15 February**, Paul Waterhouse gave a fascinating talk on "Foulshaw Moss Ospreys". Paul is warden of the Cumbria Wildlife Trust reserves at Foulshaw, Meathop and Nichols Mosses, near Grange-over-Sands. An isolated tree near the centre of Foulshaw Moss has been enhanced at its top by a platform of sticks, and for several years has become the nest of a pair of Ospreys.

A video camera at this nest has yielded the most astonishing moving pictures of three young chicks developing from their first weeks to adult birds. The male adult is seen arriving with a fish which is then torn to small pieces by the female adult and fed to the chicks.

Paul showed these video sequences, and also gave the seventy-year history of the return of Ospreys as British nesting species. The first pair nested at Loch Garten in 1954. Since then the number of known nesting pairs has increased to about 300, most of which are in Scotland, but several now in Cumbria.

The March meeting will be in the Hornby Institute at **7.45 pm on Friday 15 March**, when Tanya and Edmund Hoare will give an illustrated talk on "Saving our Swifts".

Our meetings are open to all, at £4 per individual meeting, or £10 for the complete series of six meetings during the year.

**You are a member by self-declaration** – you are a member because you say you are – and you can choose to go on the Electoral Roll (a sort of membership roll) in the parish where you live *and* in the parish where you worship (if that's somewhere else), if you are baptised and at least 16 years of age (or 15-going-on-16, effective as you turn 16).

**The new roll is now being prepared.** To enrol, just sign the list at the back of church.

**Why not do it after a Sunday service** – taking this opportunity to say, 'I want to be on the roll, and I want to take part as well'. We're here every Sunday, the active local branch of the national church – the church that says you belong the moment you say you want to belong. 10.45am every Sunday, one hour to set you up for the week.


