
JAZZ IN HORNBY

Thursday 11th April meeting

We were sad to learn that Peter Williamson will no longer be our Ward Councillor, as he has been deselected – we would like to thank him for all his support over the years, he has been a great help in many different areas and we will miss his input at our meetings.

We looked at various options to correct the large puddle that forms at the entrance of the institute car park, we are hoping to work alongside HVT and the landowner to fix this problem.

The Public Rights of Way team at Lancashire County Council will be investigating and repairing 3 stiles on the footpath from Hornby to Wray through Bridge End Farm.

Planning Applications

At the time of press we are still waiting to find out when the Story Homes application will go to planning committee, there is a meeting 29th April; the agenda will be posted online by 22nd April.

We are also waiting to learn the outcome of the Royal Oak pub development and the outline application for 28 houses on the land North of Royal Oak Meadow.

We do know that the developer of the land to the North of Royal Oak Meadow has submitted a reserved matters application, which contains detail on house type and the layout of the development, for the 23 houses that were approved on this land back in 2016.

We are watching all applications with interest.

More detailed minutes will be available in the folder in the Institute, once approved at the next meeting.

The date of the meeting in May is still to be confirmed. Once decided the agenda will be placed in the parish notice boards on the Monday prior.

As I write on Good Friday, a team of fifty local people is preparing to put on the second performance of the Hornby Passion Play, a hugely impressive production, with drama, classical and contemporary music, comedy and pathos – in the true centuries-old tradition of the telling and re-telling of the events of Holy Week in Jerusalem.

It adds to the long list of special events that will be reported at the forthcoming Annual Parish Meetings, amongst them a whole series of concerts raising funds for outside charities, events for the Armistice centenary, guest speakers for Holy Week, the completion of the 30-year overhaul of the pipe organ, and the major *Peace and Justice Week* programme in November, with eighteen guest speakers across five evenings. Summer afternoon teas, the weekly bible study, midweek services, the Mothers Union, and special events for young people, all add to the programme throughout the year. And church is open all day throughout the week for people to use to find some quiet time, and peace.

But Sunday morning is the heart of it all – of everything we are, and everything we do. For twenty centuries, people have gathered each Sunday, to hear the scriptures, and to break bread, as Jesus said, 'Do this in remembrance of me', and 'I will be with you'. It's time to reflect, it's time to re-order priorities, it's time to find strength, and resolve, and peace. It's global, it's local. It's the anchor for the week. Join us on Sundays at 10.45am.



