The AGM was held before the regular monthly meeting.

Joanna Castaldi gave her Chairman's annual report where she thanked the clerk and councillors for their support and attendance throughout the year. She reflected on the busy year which included 26 planning applications, some of which are significant and some yet to be decided upon, including Story Homes for 76 houses and the development of the Royal Oak pub.

Jacque Lloyd was appointed as the Chairman and Sara Butler as Deputy Chairman for the year 2019-2020.

We are happy to see that the estate agents have removed their advertisement boards from both Farleton road end and the pollinator patch at Strands Farm Court. We think both these areas look better now that they have been removed and we are pleased that both junctions are now safer for road users.

May we ask that you are respectful of the pollinator patches at Strands Farm and Hornby Bank. We have heard of unpleasant behaviour towards the volunteers that look after these areas. The sites in Hornby are part of a larger project and now sit within the pollinator corridor; they are there to encourage honey bees by providing nectar and pollen. We are in support of the project.

More detailed minutes will be available in the folder in the Institute, once approved at the next meeting.

The meeting in June will be held on Thursday 13th at 7.30pm. The agenda will be placed in the parish notice boards on Monday 10th June.

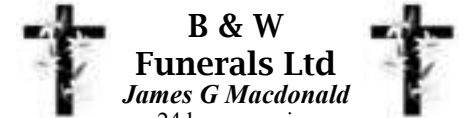
