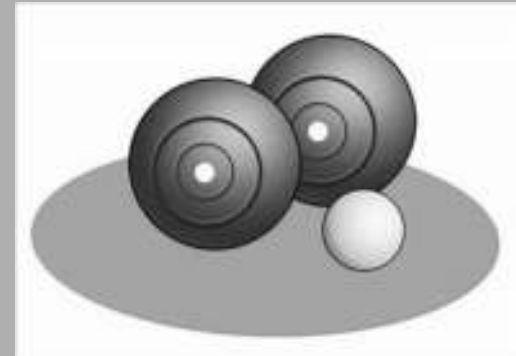

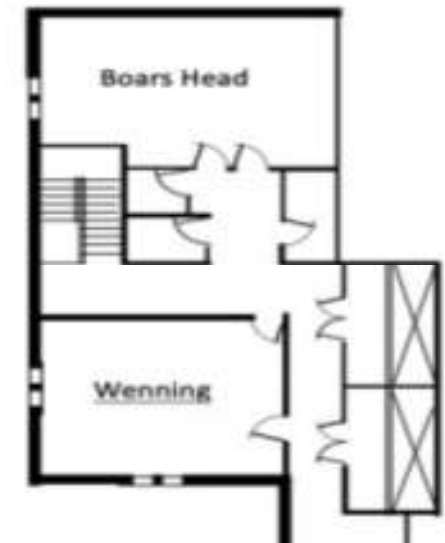

Hornby-with-Farleton Parish Council
Thursday 18th July meeting

We have spoken to the Highways department regarding traffic calming measures in the village. As I am sure many of you will agree speeding through Hornby is a significant problem.

We have been told that there are some plans in place, such as, a high-lighted informal crossing outside of the school and footpath widening over the bridge.

They currently have no proposals for either ends of the village; which is where we feel the problem would be best tackled. They have said that they will assess these locations alongside the police and consider any action that could be taken. We will be continuing our communication with the department on the matter. More detailed minutes will be available in the folder in the Institute, once approved at the next meeting.

We do not intend to hold a meeting in August, but if something arises that needs to be discussed and voted upon before our meeting in September, we will meet.

The meeting in September will be held on **Thursday 12th September** and the agenda will be placed in the parish notice boards on Monday 9th September.

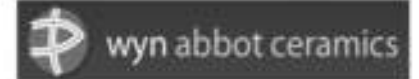
